# COVID-19 RULES REVIEWED AUGUST 2021 PASSENGERS

### Introduction

The Board has confirmed with the State Controller's office that sailing on the Lady Nelson falls under passenger transport services.

### **Passengers cannot board the vessel if they are or have had**

- current illness, or are displaying symptoms of COVID-19 (temperature, cough or sore throat) and/or are experiencing shortness of breath.
- have been in recent close contact with a person who is awaiting test results for COVID-19 or are undergoing isolation or quarantine
- have, or are in close or casual contact with, a person who has arrived from a known hotspot or overseas
- *Recent COVID-19 contact is within the last 14 days*

**If on the day if you show signs of being sick you will not be permitted to board the ship and will be asked to leave the area and seek medical advice and will be offered a refund.**

### Contact Tracing

Passengers are required to use the Check In App for contact tracing purposes. If a passenger does not have the ability to do this, contact details will be noted by the Purser and kept for a period of 28 days.

### Meeting at the Wharf

Prior to boarding the vessel, passengers will be asked to sanitise hands and reminded to use the Check In Tas App.

### Boarding and on the Vessel

If you visit the heads (toilets) please wash hands with soap and water followed by sanitiser.
