

Duke of Edinburgh's International Award Adventure Voyages

This trip it departs from Triabunna and finishes in Hobart. By departing from Triabunna we can maximize the time spent on Tasmania's spectacular East and Southeast Coast

Date: Depart Sunday the 14th Jan at 0900 from Triabunna.

Return to Hobart: Afternoon of the following Thursday 18th around 1500.

Cost: \$890 per trainee (Ship voyage only). Numbers: 10 trainees

Each person going onboard will be Covid tested (RAT) prior to boarding. Parents will need a plan if their child fails the RAT. Intrastate and Interstate an additional test prior to departure from home is a good idea. We encourage both trainees and crew to be fully Covid vaccinated.

Interstate applicants can fly in the day before Saturday 13th of January.

They can either

- billet with a Lady Nelson member* or take commercial accommodation overnight and catch the bus up in the morning. Bus departs 0700 (morning) and costs \$35 Adult >16 yo fare. * cost \$60
- Catch the bus to Triabunna and stay on the Lady Nelson overnight. Bus departs 1600 Saturday. Student cost ~\$8

For those who are local (Hobart) by arrangement will be able to undertake our Safety Induction Training and do a pre voyage day sail to begin to "learn the ropes" in the weeks prior to the voyage.

The voyage will follow a formula of one day at each station

Command and Navigation

Engineering

Catering

Deck Work.

On the final evening the trainees will select a Master, Engineer, Bosun and Cook (s) from their group and they will (with some supervision) "Bring the ship home to Hobart".

Finish time is designed so as there will be plenty of time for trainees to catch the intrastate busses and interstate flights home. Crew can escort trainees to the bus station if necessary or put them on the Skybus or in a taxi to the airport.

All crew will have "Working with Vulnerable People". There will be a male and a female crewperson assigned to be a "contact person" for the trainees onboard if they have any issues whilst onboard.

All Trainees will need to complete the online course

<https://dofoodsafely.health.vic.gov.au/index.php/en/> there are 7 training elements and an assessment to complete. Trainees will need to send a copy of the completion certificate to the Lady Nelson office.

This trip will be mostly open waters. The trainees will get more out of the trip if they are not seasick. We recommend that seasickness medication is obtained. We generally use Stugeron 15, although not available in Australia can be purchased online from Boots Chemist UK.
